and assigns free from the claim or claims of the said Peter Blay Williams  
and others or their heirs the witness whereof the said Peter Blay Williams

date first above written)

Whereas John Brother of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia  
died on his last will and testament dated his Executor to make sale of his  
real Estate and in that will appointed Bury Griffen as his Executor who as  
after duly advertising the same did on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1843 at public  
auction the land of the said Brother and Mervyn H. Williams became the  
purchaser for the sum of three hundred & five dollars: Now This Intention  
made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord 1843 Between the  
said Bury Griffen as Executor aforesaid of the one part and Mervyn H.  
Williams of the other part witnesseth that the said Bury Griffen as Executor  
aforesaid in consideration of the sum of three hundred & five dollars of  
Clementines of Virginia to him in hand paid or otherwise deserved to be paid  
by the said Mervyn H. Williams at or before the making and delivery of this  
instrument the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, to have bargained and  
sold at public auction unto the said Mervyn H. Williams his heirs and assigns  
the tract of land hereinbefore described containing agreeable to the said last  
will one hundred acres to the same North or South and bounded on the west by  
the lands of Joseph Garroway on the North by the lands of James Tidwell by  
Dane and John St. Mary and on the West by the lands James former  
inhabitant there being here well more fully appear together with all and  
singular the houses and other buildings thereon growing orchards  
land improvements ways waters and water courses hereditaments  
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in any wise  
pertaining to the said or any part or parcel thereof to have and to

hold the said land as  
herein before named, with all  
the boundaries his heirs and  
successors for himself his  
heirs and his heirs and a  
Bury Griffen as Executor  
no further shall and in
