This Indenture, the fifteenth day of October eighteen hundred and forty two  
between John D. Turner of the County of Northampton & State of North Carolina  
of the one part & Nathl Jones of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia  
of the other part that the said John D. Turner for and in consideration of the sum  
of seven hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Nathl Jones the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by  
these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Nathl Jones  
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one  
hundred & Ninety eight acres more or less lying and being in the County of  
Southampton and bounded as follows on the east by the land now in the  
possession of Mrs Sarah Turner and the north by the land of Mr Mathew  
Joyner & John Whitehead on the west by the land belonging to the estate  
of A. P. Smith on the south by the land of Nathl Jones & being the part  
of the land I purchased of Stephen A. Blount to him to hold the  
said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him  
the said Nathl Jones his heirs and assigns to the only purpose ever used  
by him of the said Nathl Jones his heirs and assigns forever and the said  
John D. Turner for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth  
hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Nathl Jones his heirs and  
assigns that he the said John D. Turner and his heirs the said tract or  
parcel of land with the appurtenances unto him the said Nathl Jones his  
heirs and assigns against him the said John D. Turner and his heirs and  
against all persons whomsoever shall and will by these presents forever warrant
