This Indenture Made and Entered into this day of August 1842
between William L. Bennett Sheriff of the County of Tewkesbury of the one
part and Edwards Bulls of the other part Whereas Littleberry Jones
some time since being in Custody of the Sheriff of Tewkesbury under an
Execution of the said Great Seal from the Clerk's office of the Circuit Superior
Court of Law and Chancery for the said County in the Name of John
Mason who died for the benefit of Edwin James & Co and being about to
avoid himself of the benefit of the land for the relief of unexpired debt
holders said debtors and debtors in & discharge of his said debtors
form and was thereupon discharged from Custody in the said
subscribed and delivered the said Littleberry Jones relinquished all
the right title and interest he had in thirty eight Lawton acre
of land which said land was conveyed by Deed of Trust to Henry
Borth for the benefit of Lewis A. Branch and whereas the said
Sheriff having given legal notice thereof on this day the day of
August 1842 sold at public auction to the highest bidder for cash
the interest right and title as aforesaid relinquished and at the
same to make the said Edwards Bulls became the purchaser
of the said right title & interest at the price of two dollars and
being the highest bid made for the said Now Therefore This
Indenture Witnesseth that the said William L. Bennett Sheriff as
aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of two Dollars to him
herein paid by the said Edwards Bulls the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold one by these presents sold
grant bargain sold unto the said Edwards Bulls his heirs and assigns
the right title and title and interest in thirty eight and a quarter
of land as relinquished as above mentioned by the said Littleberry Jones to
have and to hold the same unto him the said Edwards Bulls his heirs
and assigns against him the said William L. Bennett Sheriff as aforesaid
and those claiming through or under him In Witness whereof the said
William L. Bennett Sheriff as aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand & affixed
his seal this day and year first aforesaid
