

This Indenture Made and Entered into on the 7th day of February in the
 year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty Three between Bonnet R. Whiffles
 of the one part and Thomas B. Worrell trustees of the other part both of the County of
 Southampton State of Virginia WHEREAS the said Bonnet R. Whiffles stands
 justly indebted to the following persons Namely John M. Senter by Note for Forty
 Nine Dollars & 10 Cents due July 17 1843 David Dargatz by Note bearing date with
 these presents for Twenty five dollars to Jonathan Dorson one of my Secretaries
 as the administrators of Joseph Magill Estate such sums as they may think
 as security for me to Jacob Bonner as they become to Harrison P. Pitt
 and William S. Brown for Twenty Nine dollars & twenty five cents each note
 from June 1843 to John Hargrave by Note bearing date with these presents
 for Three hundred dollars and the said Bonnet R. Whiffles being willing and
 desirous to become the aforesaid debt Now this Indenture Witnesseth that
 for and in Consideration of the premises and also for the further convenience
 of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Thomas B. Worrell
 at and before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged he the said Bonnet R. Whiffles hath granted has
 given and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him
 the said Thomas B. Worrell his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever one
 certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and fifty two acres (More
 or less) lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Saint
 Peter and bounded by the lands of William R. Butler Esquire Neels John
 Hargrave & others two hundred Nine hundred Eighty eight sheep fifteen hogs 3 pair
 of cattle 12 Cows seven ploughs 1 horse 1 three Cattle one fine bull plough
 two horses 12 Cows 1 upperman's Trowel one Cask five firebricks two
 sleds & promises his executor shall two fine tables one walnut safe one pine
 safe one bed board 1 Clock 1 tin pail one Spoon 1 Spoon 1 Spoon 1 Spoon
 that the said Thomas B. Worrell his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
 shall permit the said Bonnet R. Whiffles to remain in quiet and peaceable
 possession of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and furniture and all the other
 property hereby conveyed or intended to be hereby conveyed until such the profits
 thereof to his own use until equal to his share in the payment of the debts aforesaid
 either in the whole or in part and then upon that further trust that the said
 Thomas B. Worrell his heirs Executors administrators or assigns shall and will to do
 after the happening of death aforesaid or the failure may request advertise and
 sell at public auction the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and all
 the other property hereby conveyed after giving at least thirty days previous notice
 of the time and place of such sale by advertisement posted up at three or more public
 places in the neighborhood and out of the proceeds of such sale first pay and
 satisfy all the said and charges attending these presents then pay over to these
 assignees to receive the above described debts and interest and the surplus if
 any pay over to the said Bonnet R. Whiffles and Thomas B. Worrell trustees have accounts
 set their names and affix their seals the day and year first above written
