assignees forever on Mannor and terms following: that is to say upon trust hereby
left that the said J.D. Maffenburg his executors and administrators shall forth
the said Thomas Lawrence to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of said
tract of land and slaves and take the profits thereof to his own use until
defeas'd on the payment of the aforementioned Note of one Thousand dollars and
interest which may thereon accrue either in whole or part and thereupon
the further trust that the said J.D. Maffenburg his executors or administrators
will do soon after the happening of said default as he may then and there be
required either by the said Thomas Lawrence or the said James Wells or either
of their executors or administrators make sale at public auction of said tract of
land and slaves or as much thereof as may be necessary to make payment of
the aforesaid interest and cost of this trust having given at least
twenty days notice of the time and place of sale by advertisement at the last
house door or some court day or other public place in the County and out of
the County arising from such sale shall after defraying the charges thereof and after
expenses attending the premises pay to the said James Wells his executors administrators
or assigns the sum sum of one thousand dollars with the interest accrued and the
balance of any sum paid by the said Thomas Lawrence his executors or administrators
out of the whole of said sum of one Thousand dollars shall be fully paid off and
discharged by the said Thomas Lawrence to him the said James Wells or before this
