This Indenture Made this 5 day of March in the year of our Lord Eight hundred and forty four between Blunt Lester and Peggy his wife of one part and James Stamps of the other part - all of the County of Southampton parishes of Netley and state of Virginia witnesseth that the said Blunt Lester and Peggy his wife in consideration of the sum of Sixteen dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said James Stamps before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and make them sets bargains and sell unto the said James Stamps his heirs and assigns forever tract or parcels of land containing Two acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows: beginning at a lightwood post at the road, a corner of said land of James Stamps line thence up the road to another lightwood post @ corner of his land & Big Brother line thence by said Brother line to a fence @ corner of said land and a few rods off between Blunt & Lester's line to @ corner of said Stamps and thence to the beginning together with all and singular the houses and houses before belonging good garms wroth waggons and water courses porches piaffes commodeys easements emblements hereditaments and appartenances whatsoever in the said land belonging with every part and parcel thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof: It shall and will be held the said Two acres of land therewith with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned is intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof ready every of their rights members and appartenances unto the said James Stamps his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose use and behooff him the said James Stamps his heirs and assigns forever and the said Blunt Lester and Peggy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appartenances before mentioned unto the said James Stamps his heirs and assigns free from all claims or demands of them or either of their heirs and gill and during other persons or persons whatsoever shall and will remain and forever defend by these presents: In witness whereof the said Blunt Lester and Peggy his wife hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first above written.
