This Indenture Made and Entered into on this 10 day of March — year 1844
by and between Augustus Pape of the one part and James Howell of the other, both
of whom resides in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia: This indenture
Witnesseth that the said Augustus Pape have for and in Consideration of the sum of
Two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the above named James Howell at and
before the recording and delivery of these presents and in Consideration of which he the
said Augustus Pape doth bargained and sold and with hunc gerat Bargains and sold
unto him the said James Howell a certain parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid
said County of Southampton and bounded to certain survey five acres of land same bounded
as follows beginning at a black gun standing in the west branch thereof ready @ south
East corner up @ certain trees to a pond thence ready East to a first rock now and
ever of family made or corner in John Mc Neels line thence along said rock line North @ south
Elen forwad to the next branch thence up said branch to the beginning to him the said James
Howell so tract and to hold the said lot or parcel of land with the appurtenances
therein belonging together with all the right little interest and title which he the
said Augustus Pape has heretofore had in and to the said land to him the said
James Howell and to his heirs and assigns forever and his other said Augustus Pape
also hereby warrant a few simple datals in said land to have the said James Howell
his heirs and assigns forever no rights wherof be the said Augustus Pape has heretofore
but has none and affirme his deal the day and year first above written

This Indenture Made and entered into this the twentieth day of February on the year of our
Lord eighteen hundred and forty four between Benjamin Drew & McNeel his wife of the County of
Southampton of the first part & Robert Dold of the County of Southampton of the other part
of the value of one hundred & forty four pounds Sterling & twenty shillings (£144/-) being the right
of inheritance of the said Benjamin (Drew) for in Consideration of this sum of Thirtys dollars to him
in hand paid by the said Robert Dold (the rest of which is hunc gerat acknowledged) the said
Benjamin (Drew) & McNeel his wife doth by these presents bargains sell moreover releases
unto him the said Robert Dold his heirs & assigns forever all their interest right & claim
in it to a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton containing
as appears a bout one hundred & twenty acres (for the same more or less) it being the right
& interest which Robert Stephenson had in a certain tract of land on the death of his Mother
Mary Stephenson which by the will of his Father was left to him & his two brothers Miles
J. John Stephenson: all of which and more fully appears by reference to the will of Thomas
Stephenson Father of the P. Robert Stephenson & John & Miles Stephenson: It doth also to hold
the said tract or parcel of land to him the said Robert Dold his heirs & assigns forever
And the said Benjamin (Drew) & McNeel his wife doth by these presents warrant &
