This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty three between David Evans and Anna Matilda his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Bishopton of the one part and James Farmer of the other part witnesseth that the said David Evans and Anna Matilda his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said James Farmer the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained sold and released and by these presents with great bargains and deal unto the said James Farmer to him and his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of Land containing to determine being some by the name of Rose or Self and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a tree cutt a few rods from the junction of two small branches and a hillside going down thence along a line of hillside back to a branch running between the P. Lane and Seven Mile Run line to a small gully at the head where a line of nuttall trees along the side of the road to a rock out by road comes down in Shadwell Branch and Devil's Lane line thence to a fence and thence down hillside to a fence a few rods from the junction of two small branches a stone line to the first station together with all land and houses thereon belonging to the said land with all
