This Indenture made the 26 day of February 1844 between Henry Storer of the 1st part and Matthew Vaughan of the other part Willelme that the said Henry Storer in consideration of the sum of two hundred and Ninety five Dollars to him on hand paid by the said Matthew Vaughan at or before the date hereof and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged to have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Matthew Vaughan a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing one hundred and sixty three and one half acres bounded by the lands of Matthew Vaughan on the East - North by the lands of Anthony Vaughan and South by of the same tract and thence North West by the land of Aaron Vaughan &c and the remaining and uninclosed remainder and remainder yearly and every year and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said one hundred and sixty three and one half acres with the tenements hereunto and all and singular other the premises hereunto mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto Henry of these rights hereunto and appertained unto the said Matthew Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Storer for himself and his heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appertained before mentioned
