

His Indenture made at 17th day of March in the year one thousand
eight hundred and forty four between Benjamin Brown and Rose Brown and Francis
Brown the Mother and Francis Brown the daughter of the one part and Thomas
Drake of the other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin Brown Esq: Brown
Francis Brown and Francis Brown in consideration of the sum of seven Dollars and
of lawful Money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said
Thomas Drake at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Plaintiff
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents
do and make of them bargains and sell unto the said Thomas Drake his heirs and
assigns a certain tract or parcel lying in the County of Southampton and containing
the sum of Sixty Acres of which was bought of Zachariah Lamberton Lamberton
being fifty six acres four of which were bought of Zachariah Lamberton together
with all the buildings houses, barns stables yards gardens orchards
Lands tenements messuages pastures feedings common roads watercourses ways waters
waters courses featuring fenceing fixtures instruments implements advantages embellishments
hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to this said Land belonging or appertaining
or which this donee takes and accepts or hereafter requested takes or becomes in fact
purchased or receives thereof as as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the possession
or successive remainder or remainderancy yearly and other rents annuall and profits thereof
of every part and parcel thereof of liberty and to hold the said 66 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres land
with the tenement hereditaments and all and singular other than the premises herein
before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel
thereof with lesing of their rights numbers and appurtenances unto this said Thomas
Drake his heirs and assigns forever to and for ever longer time and behoof of him
the said Thomas Drake his heirs and assigns forever unto the said Benjamin Brown
Esq: Brown and Francis Brown and Francis Brown for themselves and their heirs
the said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances
before mentioned unto the said Thomas Drake his heirs and assigns free from all
claims or claims of them the said Benjamin Brown Esq: Brown and Francis Brown
or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every former or present
whatsoever shall and will be or appear and forever defend by these presents in
