

This Sixteenth Day of November in the year of Christ
1843 between Edw^t B. Hunter of the County of Hampshire of the one part and
W^m Ball of the County of Southampton of the other part Whereas the said

Johnston of the last named County are now in arrears and promises for the
payment of a sum given by him to George W^m Ball of this County of
eight pounds for the payment of forty dollars and by bond payable 25 day
Jan 1843 and bearing date 1st of Jan 1843 and executed in the Clerk's
office of Southampton County Court on the said 1st of Jan 1843 and money to the sum
of £8.00 sterling amount other things all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being
in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing forty eight acres both
demesne and freehold bounded as follows to w^e, on the Wall and South by the
water arood the west - by Thomas A. Walker land and on the North Allen
Edwards 100^{ft} Lawrence's land together with all the buildings and improvements
thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging in Street Rowhouse and with
power and authority to the said Edw^t B. Hunter to sell the same for the purpose of
paying the said debt and the expenses attending the execution of the said bond
if the said Johnn Johnston should fail to discharge the said bond agreeably to the
terms and effect thereof Whenever after such default the said George W^m Ball
gives a sum theroy to his Master and wheroy the said George Johnston having
failed to pay the said debt agreeably to the terms and effect of the said bond
and the said George W^m Ball having in consequence thereof acquired as by
the said bond of title to his Master for the purpose aforesaid the said Edw^t B. Hunter
Execution of the said bond after giving ten days notice of the terms place and time of
date by causing advertisements to be placed at County publick places as he shall
require set on this day upon the premises before to have a publick auction to the
highest bidder for ready Money the said tract of Land with improvements and
appurtenances and at this date as Master this aforesaid 100^{ft} Ball becomes the
purchaser of the said tract of Land with the improvements and appurtenances by
dealing theroy the sum of Forty three dollars which was the highest bid given
for the same and that sum he has since paid to the said Edw^t B. Hunter
Now This Sixteenth Instant witnesseth that the said Edw^t B. Hunter grants no
consideration of the said sum which he has received from the said 100^{ft} Ball as
aforesaid above sum given by him and sets and by these presents doth
grant - bargains sell and convey unto the said 100^{ft} Ball his heirs and assigns
the said tract of land hereinbefore mentioned and contained together with the
buildings and improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging to
him and to have the said tract of Land with all the buildings and other
improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging and all the rents
right titles and interest of the said Edw^t B. Hunter therein unto the said 100^{ft}
Ball his heirs and assigns to his and their very proper use and beho^ff forever and by
said Edw^t B. Hunter for himself his heirs executors and administrators freely
covenant to and with the said 100^{ft} Ball his heirs and assigns that he will
forever maintain and defend the said tract of land hereby conveyed with the
buildings and improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging
to the said 100^{ft} Ball his heirs and assigns against the claims of the said
Edw^t B. Hunter and all persons claiming the same or any part thereof by
force through or under claim the said Edw^t B. Hunter but against themselves
