This Indenture made this 16th day of March in the year 1824 by and
between Richard B. Edwards of the first part; Jacob Barnes of the second part; and
Ferguson Williams & Reynolds of the last party all of whom resides in the County of Southampton
Now This Indenture witnesseth that the said Richard B. Edwards doth
justly owe to the said William & Reynolds in the sum of two hundred and
twenty four dollars appearing as well by bond as this indenture both of which
was reduced this said Richard B. Edwards is willing and desirous to agree and
desires the payment of the said sum of two hundred and twenty four dollars
together with the legal interest which shall commence on the date and
all cost which may or shall be incurred in the full execution of this bond and
for the further consideration of one action in hand past by the said Jacob Barnes
the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and paid to the party of which he
does Jacob Barnes and all his legal representatives are forever released thereof
and discharged by the said Richard B. Edwards who hereby grants bargains
and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes two certain tracts or parcels of land
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded by the lands
of this following named persons to wit one lot by Gilbert H. Ferguson, Benjamin
J. Barnard, Edward Howell and perhaps others and subject to certain 41 acres of
land the other lot by Benjamin J. Barnard, Josiah Howell and Miles Cook
supposed to contain thirty acres of land to the same more or less to him the
said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever hereby conveying to him the said
Jacob Barnes all the right title interest and estates of in and to the said lots
of land with all the appurtenances to the same belonging
To him and to hold the said land and tenancy part and parcel thereof
to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever and to him
hereinafter it is to say of the said Richard B. Edwards pays the
foregoing debt of two hundred and twenty four dollars with the interest
which shall run from together with the cost of recovering this indenture
at or before he shall so require to do by the said William & Reynolds
his executors administrators or assigns that same and on that date when the said
Jacob Barnes his heirs executors or administrators shall release all the said lands
conveyed to him the said Jacob Barnes to have the said Richard B. Edwards
such person or persons as shall at that time be legally entitled to the same
but on condition that he shall pay to the said Richard B. Edwards and the
aforesaid interest, charges and cost of recovering this indenture shall be left
at or before the said William & Reynolds his executors or assigns to whomsoever
receives the same that same and on that date it shall be the language of them
the said Jacob Barnes if required by either party to do at such time for such
as much or all of the two lots of land as will make money sufficient to discharge
the aforesaid debt of two hundred and twenty four dollars after the aforesaid
sums as well as the recovery of this indenture and reasonable compensation to be
recovered by him the said Barnes for his personal trouble in the full execution

of this indenture and all
cost interest and cost as a
Sheriff or his bailiffs has or
comes in his hands any fine
imprisonment and costs aforesaid
shall be recovered of him
