This INDENTURE made and entered into this 18th day of March in the year
of our Lord 1844 between Edmunds Nash of the one part and William Mynor of
the other part - Whereas Edmunds Nash by an instrument bearing date the 19th day
of June 1843 and admitted to record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County on the
same day for the purpose of becoming a manufacturer John H. Williams who was
deceased for the said Butts to @ certain land situated & described in the said indenture
against all his & injury on account of the said manufactory did convey unto the said
to Wherad Nash among other property the following land to wit - his said late
Butts' widow and undivided interest in the tract of land whereof the late Sarah
Butts was sole & perfect owner three thirds of the entire tract of land which contained
four hundred & eighty acres and more or less with all privileges & appurtenances thereto
said land on and since aforesaid and belonging Upster Street and with power
and authority to the said Edmunds H. Nash after being required to do by the said
John H. Williams his heirs Executors or administrators after the death of the said
Butts to pay the said sum of money for which the said Williams was his decedent
to make sale of the aforesaid land at public auction to the highest bidder for cash
for the purpose of paying the debt for which the said Williams was deceased, or otherwise
to give the said Williams such sum of money as he may have been compelled to pay the
debt with interest thereon, and Wherad Nash having been
requested so to do by the said John H. Williams and having sold on the day and place
of date & given reasonable public notice thereof as on this day set up one bill at
full auction to the highest bidder for cash the said interest in the aforesaid lands
as described aforesaid together with the privilege and appurtenances thereto and all
the case to make the aforesaid William Mynor become the purchaser of the said
interest in the said land withs privilege and appurtenances by bidding therefor the sum
of Three hundred and two dollars which was the highest bid made for the same
Now Therefore This Indenture WITNESSED that the said Edmunds H. Nash
for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and two dollars which he
has received from the said William Mynor has granted bargained and sold and by
these presents does grant bargained sell and convey unto the said William Mynor
his heirs Executors executors and assigns the aforesaid interest in the land herein before
mentioned & described together with the buildings and improvements thereon and the
appurtenances thereto belonging To him & to hold the said interest in the
said land with all the buildings & other improvements thereon and the appurtenances
