This Indenture Made this 1st day of April one Thousand eight-

and forty four between Cadwell Howell of the first part William Holt of the
second part and Nelson Howell of the third part - WITNESSETH that the said
Cadwell Howell is fully enabled to the said William Howell and the sum of one
hundred and Fifty Dollars by bond bearing date ninth these presents and being
anything and whatsoever to leave to the said William Howell the debt aforesaid and
for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar or thereabouts paid by the said
William Holt to the said Cadwell Howell before the concluding and delivery of these
aforesaid presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold
W.H. Howell by these presents coming unto the said William Holt his heirs or assigns the
following property to w^t 2 cows 2 heifers and furniture 1 Young steer 1 cow 1 heifer
2 pigs 2 flocks 1 young fawn 1 shield 1 oven 1 cupboard 3 tables 10 chairs 2 grand
chessboard and kitchen furniture 1 floor planter 1 stool 1 chest 3 boxes a lot of
chickens 2 geese 15 bushels of corn 250 pounds of bacon 200 lbs of fodder 3 axes, iron
molded 1 hatchet 1 long but 1 saw 1 chisel and one mallet upon this special trust
that the said William Holt shall pay unto the said Cadwell Howell to remain in
possession of the above property until his death to entitle by the said William
Howell to make sale of the same for the purpose of satisfying the debt aforesaid and
the said William Howell shall have full power and authority at any time to direct
the said William Holt to advertise the above named property by giving two
days notice at some or more public places in this County and sell to the highest bidder

County of Southampton at the last March Sesssion to sell the undivided interest of George
Brown James Purdy and Lucy Ann J. Purdy his widow in the tract of land of which
George Brown died seized of the same and retained 1/3 part of the other part
Witnesseth that whereas the said Jacob Barnard has this day received of public sale
to the highest bidder no less than the sum of six Months as by said decree awarded and directed
Smith having become the purchaser at the sum of Three hundred and thirty Dollars
