This Indenture Made and ratified on the fifthteenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and Forty four between Thomas Lawrence of the first part James Q. Moxbury of the second part and Elizabeth Carson and Jonathan Carson of the third part Whereas the said Thomas Lawrence is justly indebted in several sums for which the above named Elizabeth Carson and Jonathan Carson are bound as Security to and one Note executed to Jonathan Carson about a horse and of Moxbury for some hundred and Forty two dollars the bearing date the 19th day of July 1841 They the said Elizabeth Carson and Jonathan Carson being also Security for the said Thomas Lawrence as Surety of James Schuler Jensen and the said Thomas Lawrence being desirous of fully paying and indemnifying the said Elizabeth Carson and the said Jonathan Carson against any loss by means of said Security as well as in all and every other case in which the said Elizabeth Carson and Jonathan Carson or either of them may be bound as Security for the said Thomas Lawrence and also to secure the payment of a debt to Elizabeth Carson as Surety of the rightness of Moxbury's Now This Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of one dollar current money to the said Thomas Lawrence paid by the said James Q. Moxbury the said Thomas Lawrence hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said James Q. Moxbury the following property to wit: Lewis Peter Miles Esq's share four head and quarters of horses one stall one four wheel carriage stock of all hand horse hets and kitchen furniture with all the plantation lots of every kind crop ground land and other things he must the present year at the time of sale and also the tract of land whereon the said Thomas Lawrence now resides and the land included in a certain deed executed by the said Lawrence for the benefit of James Wells and now in the office of the County Court - or such part of said tract of land and slaves as may remain after paying and satisfying the debt due to the said James Wells of \$1800 and to hold the said slaves with the said horse carriage stock and crop and also the said tract of land premises and appurtenances unto him the said James Q. Moxbury his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever Upon Joint Tenants ship that the said Thomas Lawrence shall remain in possession of said property until payment in the form of said debt or until there is a thirty hour that the said Elizabeth Carson and Jonathan Carson will become debtors or greatly inconvenienced by having to pay there by reason of the aforesaid security and then upon their further trust that upon the release of the said Thomas Lawrence from the said Elizabeth Carson or
