This Indenture Made this 5 day of March in the year of our Lord thousand eight hundred and thirty four between Joseph Jaynes and Henry his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Stephenson of the same County and State of the other part (Westchester) that the said Joseph Jaynes and Henry his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty seven dollars current Money of Virginia to have and to pay to the said William Stephenson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged with great pleasure seal also -affixed and confirmed unto the said William Stephenson to him and to his heirs forever and certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and Twenty eight and one half acres to the said lands more or less and bounded as follows to west beginning at a point a corner of Joseph Jaynes between Stevens River and the said Joseph Jaynes and by the said Stevens River to the said lands called the long branch, thence up the same toward thence to a black gum a corner of Joseph Jaynes and James Colgroves river thence to straight line of Market trees between James Colgrove and Joseph Jaynes to a fence corner of the said Joseph Jaynes and James Colgrove thence along a line of Market trees to a white oak a corner of the lands of Stevens Stevens river and the said Joseph Jaynes thence to straight line of Market trees to the first station together with all houses and lands before mentioned lands Stevens Stevens river and market trees and all other land adiacent thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said land or part of land with premises \$16 75 and it is desired that the said title to the said William Stephenson to have and to his heirs forever and the said Joseph Jaynes and Henry his wife for themselves their executors administrators and assigns make by these presents renounce and grant to and unto the said William Stephenson his heirs executors administrators and assigns that all those parcels they will receive and former defend all the right title claim or claims of any person claiming a dominion over the same or may find thereof In witness
