Town of Portsmouth in the state of New Hampshire and Jacob Barnes of the County of  
Southampton this Indenture witnesseth that the said Margaret Whitfield having  
for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred twenty five dollars and four  
cents to her on hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at and before the making  
and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have  
bargained and sold and by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto him  
the said Jacob Barnes all my right Title interest and estate of in and to the  
estate of George Whitfield deceased real and personal: to have and to hold  
such interest with all the appurtenances to the said interest belonging or in any  
way appertaining to him the said Jacob Barnes and to his heirs and assigns forever  
free from any manner of claim or demand and respects myself my heirs executors  
administrators and also free from the claim of any and every person or persons  
whatsoever who might and title as aforesaid to do hereby warrant and will  
further afford to have the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever in  
Milner where I have herunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day  
and year first above written
