been fully paid off and discharged by the said John B. Mann his heirs or assigns ever
before the 28 day of October 1843 so that a part of payment was made and received

John Edwards having received thereof to sell the land conveyed in said deed of Trust
and satisfy the debt the said John Edwards after having advertised the same and

place of sale as in said Deed in full proceed on the 28 day of October 1843 and
sold the said tract or parcel of Land to the highest bidder for ready

Money whom Mordeca Broadshaw became the last bidder and purchaser for the sum of
124 dollars upon which after deducting the necessary expenses attending the sale the

balance paid to the said Mordeca Broadshaw as in said deed required Now This Indenture
Witnesseth that for the considerations aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of the

sum of 124 dollars in hand paid by the said Mordeca Broadshaw to the said John Edwards
at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged by the said John Edwards both orally and in writing and that and by
these presents doth give bargain and sell unto the said Mordeca Broadshaw his heirs

and assigns the aforesaid tract or parcel of land that is to say all the whole right title
interest claim and demand both at Law and Equity which the said John Edwards here

held in the said Tract or parcel of Land hereint described To Have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of land to the said Mordeca Broadshaw his heirs and assigns forever

to the proper use and behoof of him the said Mordeca Broadshaw his heirs and assigns forever
and the said John Edwards for himself and his heirs Executors and administrators the

above mentioned tract or parcel of land unto the said Mordeca Broadshaw his heirs and
assigns in as full and ample manner as was warranted by the said John B. Mann by the

Deed of Trust herein recited as warrant the same to the said Mordeca Broadshaw
against the claims or claims of him the said John Edwards by or under him In Witness
