Williams on the 5 day of the month of March of the present year in the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for Southamptown County for one hundred and one dollars & twenty eight cents with interest from the 15 day of March 1842 till paid & costs also the sum of eleven dollars & 68 cents & another sum of eleven dollars due by him which are in the hands of Benjamin Bond Constable In Consideration whereof for the further Consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said John R. Brater the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said John R. Brater his heirs assigns all his the said Anthony R. Williams interest in a certain tract of land lying & being in the County of Southamptown containing by Certificates owned by the same there or left to buy the tract of land on which offering Williams Brater of the said Anthony R.
