 a debt of \$178.12 wanted to be allowed by a former court: Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of
 one act to have the said John B. Booker in hand paid by the said James St. John
 at and before the writing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said John B. Booker unto your honorable court and seal and
 by these presents said give grant bargain & sell to the said James St. John his
 heirs and assigns forever the said John B. Booker unto every copy of every kind he
 here made this year (1784) say copy of every former or better present and seal
 To have and to hold to the said James St. John his heirs and assigns forever
 upon Trust notwithstanding that the said James St. John shall at the request of
 either one of the aforesaid parties after giving at least Ten days notice of his time
 and place of sale sell at public auction for cash all the property of present or
 hereby conveyed or to be so conveyed as well by sufficient to satisfy all the aforesaid
 claims interest & cost and out of the proceeds first pay the expenses thereof
 by this act of buying, their actions and 1/100 together with int. and cost due
 to E. H. P. Piper Sheriff and Lastly pay the said Deibel's cost and Credit. Q. Bookman
 John S. Adams P. P. Parsons the J. D. Anderson Deibel Joseph S. Bookman
 Daniel Bellinger and John Williamson and Nicholas Deibel and the Balance
 of any sum due to the said John B. Booker or his legal representatives and the said
 John B. Booker covenants binds the said James St. John that he is sufficient
 estate for simple right in the property hereby conveyed and that he will give
 warrant and defend the same against himself and all other persons whatsoever but
