

Virginia, in the just and full sum of three thousand dollars for the time past
 of which we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally
 to pay to whom presents made with our seals and dates this 20 day of May 1814.
 The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Anthony M. Howell
 Esq^r of the County of Southampton has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as
 constable within the said County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of
 Hamm Edwards; Now if the said Anthony M. Howell shall well and truly discharge
 the duties of the office of constable in the said County during his continuance therein
 then the above obligation to be void or else remain in full force and virtue.

This Indenture Made and entered into this the 15 day of May 1814 Between Patrick H. Rollings and John his wife of the first part Littleton R. Edwards of the second part and
 Edwards Bull of the third party whereas the said Edwards Bull hath become security for the
 said Patrick H. Rollings in a forthcoming bond in favor of John M. Howell upon one
 recognizance given from the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton
 County and which said attorney bond is for the sum of Three hundred and six dollars & twenty
 nine cents principal bearing date the 15 day of December 1813 also the said Patrick H.
 Rollings stands indebted to the said Edwards Bull in a sum of one hundred
 Twenty four dollars & Nine cents bearing date the 15 day of May 1814 and whereas
 the said Patrick H. Rollings and John his wife are anxious to secure and have agreed to make
 and save him the said Bull from all loss damages whatsoever by encroaching unto the
 said Littleton R. Edwards the property herein after mentioned in trust to be held for their daughters
 Ness therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Patrick H. Rollings and John his wife
 as well for and in consideration of the promises after the further transmission of the sum of one
 dollar to him by the said Littleton R. Edwards in hand paid this receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged) have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 alien enfranchise and confer unto him the said Littleton R. Edwards a certain tract or parcel
 of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing Two hundred and Forty acres
 to be the same more or less at the place or parts stated to the said John in this writing or in the course
 of his deceased Father John Both references to the extent of the Commissioners' Survey to
 the County Court of Southampton at its March Term 1813 and more fully appear made
 at and before the premises and affiancements whatsoever to the said tract of land or part
 of land belonging even any more or less than all my right title and interest in the several
 shares of Little Point, waters of Patrick's Pond, namely Abel Mason's, John and Nancy
 which right title more fully appear by reference to a bill of sale of said John and Nancy
 bearing date the 15 day of May 1813 also twenty two of miles and their increase to have
 and to hold the said tract of land or part of land and premises and its affiancements together
 with all my right title and interest in this several share of Little Point, waters of Patrick's
 Pond and all other property herein conveyed to the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs and
 assigns forever upon trust. Notwithstanding that it shall and may be lawful for the said
