This Indenture Made and entered into this 15 day of May 1784 between Patrick
H. Howells and Ann his wife of the first part Lillian R. Edwards of the second part and
Edwards Bulls of the third part Whereas the said Edwards Bulls have become security for the
said Patrick H. Howells in a forthcoming bond in favor of John M. Holland upon and
Executors which bond from the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton
County and which said forthcoming bond is for the sum of Three hundred and six dollars Thirty
Nine cents principle bearing date the 17 day of December 1783 also the said Patrick H.
Howells stands indebted to the said Edwards Bulls in a bond for the sum of one hundred
Twenty four dollars & two cents bearing date the 15 day of May 1784 and whereas
the said Patrick H. Howells and Ann his wife are anxious to remove and have agreed to remove
and have bound the said Bulls from all loss or damage whatsoever by conveying unto the
said Lillian R. Edwards the property herein after mentioned in Trust to be sold for that purpose
NOW Therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Patrick H. Howells and Ann his wife
as well for and in consideration of the premises also the further consideration of the sum of one
dollar to him by the said Lillian R. Edwards in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged have granted bargained and sold with all their presents or grant hereunto well
them well-off and confirm unto him the said Lillian R. Edwards a certain tract or parcel of
land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing Two hundred and Fifty rods
be the same more or less situate the portion situate to the said Ann in the eastern of the
lands of her deceased Father John Smith reference to the report of the Commissioners made to
the County Court of Southampton at its March Term 1780 and more fully appear with
all and singular the premises and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land from or parcel
of land belonging even any mess appurtenances all my right title and interest in the above
slaves of Pelly Pond widow of Patrick's said Namely Abel Mason join and Ann
which right well more fully appear by reference to a bill of sale from John Bull
bearing date the 15 day of May 1781 also Twenty head of cattle and their increase To Have
and to hold the said land from or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances together
with all my right title and interest in the above slaves of Pelly Pond widow of Patrick's
said and all other property herein conveyed to the said Lillian R. Edwards his heirs and
assigns forever Upon Trust that she shall and may be lawful for the said
