 said James Horrell of (ffair) running thence East & libt 160 feet to a lightwood post a corner
 in Henry Poper's land to thence to hold the said tract or parcel of land with its
 appurtenances to him the said James Horrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Augustus Soper West Poper and Henry Joyner hereby covenant and agree to and with the said
 James Horrell his heirs and assigns that they will keep forever neare and defend the
 title to the said tract or parcel of land and promises with its appurtenances and him the

This Indenture made this the first day of May in the year of our Lord 1841 between
 John Cobb and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and
 John Cobb of the same County of the other part Wiltshire that the said John Cobb and Elizabeth
 his wife first and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars lawful money of Virginia
 to him or her paid by the said John Cobb (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) doth
 these presents give grant bargained sell and convey unto the said John Cobb his heirs and assigns
 a certain portion of land situate in Southampton aforesaid bounded and described as follows
 (viz) on the east by the Colham road North to John M. Williams land South by 8 rods back
 fence and west by the Indian Branch containing one hundred and thirty rods together with
 all the premises unto appertaining to the said land in any way appertaining and belonging to
 the said John Cobb and to hold the above granted premises to the said John Cobb his heirs and assigns to him and
 their uses and behoof forever and that the said John Cobb and Elizabeth his wife do covenant
 for themselves and their heirs and executors and administrators unto the said John Cobb his heirs and assigns
 that they are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises that they are free from all
 incumbrances that they have given right to deal and convey the same to the said John Cobb as
 aforesaid and that they will make due care have executed and administered their covenant and indenture
 to the said John Cobb his heirs and assigns against the lawful demands
