This Indenture Made and entered into this 25 day of April in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Elbridge G. Hunt of the first part Arthur  
 W. Holman of the second part; and Elizabeth Wiles of the third part all of the County of Southampton  
 To Term and state of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Elbridge G. Hunt for and in consideration of  
 Colobation the sum of six, eight dollars and seventy five cents which said sum is due from the said  
 Elbridge G. Hunt to Benjamin L. Drew by bond, bearing date 25 day of April one thousand  
 eight hundred and forty four which bond the said Elizabeth Wiles is bound for as security to  
 perform the said Elbridge G. Hunt and to bind due to the Sheriff of the County of one hundred and  
 to P. Debs seven eight dollars and fifty eight cents given to undersigned, and the said Sheriff to make him  
 to sell the property of Richard Bonds of the County to satisfy a debt due by the said Bonds to the said  
 Elbridge G. Hunt and to the said Sheriff the day of April one thousand eight hundred and forty  
 four as well as all other Monies which may be due and owing from the said Elbridge G. Hunt to  
 the said Elizabeth Wiles by Means of any writings transfer of debt or paper whatever as also for  
 and in consideration of one dollar to the one hand first by the said Arthur W. Holman this  
 receipt whereof the said Elbridge G. Hunt doth hereby acknowledge had granted bargained and sold  
 and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell, convey and make over unto the said  
 Arthur W. Holman and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit  
 one Negro Man Wills one sent horse one slender land and Barnyard and the several crops of corn  
 garden &c belonging to him the said Elbridge G. Hunt. To Have and to hold with all the  
 right and interest of the said Elbridge G. Hunt hereunto conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him  
 the said Arthur W. Holman his heirs and assigns forever upon the special covenants Warranties that  
 the said Arthur W. Holman upon being thereto required by the aforesaid Elizabeth Wiles shall  
 forward to sell all the right and interest of the said Elbridge G. Hunt to the above named property  
 hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the same and place in the said County  
 of Southampton for Ten days previous at some public house or store for Cash and out of the Money  
 arising and to forward the said sale on the first day of May and satisfy all cost attending the said  
 sale as well as the expenses attending this conveyance and then pay off the said Elbridge G. Hunt  
 to the said Elizabeth Wiles by Means of any writings transfer of debt or paper whatever and the  
 surplus of any pay to the said Elbridge G. Hunt and the said Elbridge G. Hunt for himself his  
 heirs executors and administrators the right and title of the said property unto the said Arthur W.  
 Holman his heirs and assigns forever doth hereby warrant and defend against the lawful claims  
 or claims of him the said Elbridge G. Hunt his heirs executors and administrators and against all  
 and every other person or persons whatsoever and the said Arthur W. Holman or his heirs covenants  
 and agrees that he will make date of this right and interest hereby conveyed for the best price  
 he can obtain for the same after advertising the same and place for Ten days previous at some public  
 house or store in the said County and with the Monies arising from the said first pay and satisfy  
 all cost attending the same as well as the expenses attending this conveyance and then pay off the  
 aforesaid debt and interest as well as all the Monies which may appear to the said Arthur W.  
 Holman to be fairly due and owing from the said Elbridge G. Hunt to the said Elizabeth Wiles
