 lastes for and on consideration of the sume of one thousand dollars to them or herne paid
 by the said Elizabeth & Anna Williams Virginia Birth & Committee Williams all as before in
 dealeing & delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Robert Heiley Anne Heiley
 doth hereby acknowledge and thorwifc affirme and discharge the said Elizabeth & A Williams
 Virginia Birth & Committee Williams their heirs executors & administrators forever by these
 presentes they the said Robert's Anne Heiley have granted bargained and sold above
 esteemed and confirmed and by these presents such grant bargains sell above esteemed and
 confirmed unto the said Elizabeth & A Williams Virginia Birth & Committee Williams the
 said one affreight or otherwise tract or parcel of land situate lying and lying in the
 County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded by the lines of Joseph St Cuthbert alias of
 Edward Price and Nancy Miller Robert Heiley Peter D. Burkman Williams & Jonathan
 it being the tract of land aforesaid to Robert Heiley by Nancy Miller and as by
 said Deed bearing date the thirtieth day of April one thousand eight hundred and nine and
 Recited the County first day of August 1819 now fully affirme containing four hundred
 & four acres to the same more or less together with all houses and houses before bearing
 aforesaid way water courses natural law grounds pastures commonable buildings and
 appurtenances whatsoever and the fixtures and furniture and ornaments and
 plates and furniture things and all the sets of little utensils uses tract aforesaid
 property taught alarm and demand of whom the said Robert's Anne Heiley doth make the
 same my and every tract thereof and unto executors & administrators bearing or commanding the
 same premises to have and to hold our aforesaid tract or parcel of land and former
 hereinafore mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Elizabeth & A Virginia Birth
 their heirs and affres for ever to the end Elizabeth & A Williams Virginia Birth
 their heirs and affres for ever to the end Robert Heiley and their heirs & affres for ever to the said

 said Robert's Anne Heiley and their heirs and affres shall make demand and power

 formerly of present before in no County aforesaid and living now deceased by her former self
 from her husband and having the said Robert Heiley fully informed & her she the A. Heiley
 exchange the sume to be had and to held and retained that she had nothing against whom so
 named the sume and that she was satisfied therewith under oath and subscribed
 the 28th March 1819:
