This indenture made and entered into this 1st day of June 1844 between Margaret to
some of the one part and Edmund Buell of the other part, both of the County of Washington
in the state of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said Margaret & some for and in consideration
of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Edmund Buell
(the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) she has granted bargained and sold and by these
fore said does grant bargain and sell above writt and convey unto the said Edmund Buell his
heirs and assigns as certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid
consisting by Estimation one hundred and eleven acres more or less and bounded on the South
by the lands of former said Buell on the West by the lands of John Simmons on the East
by the lands belonging to the heirs of Joseph Drury and on the North by the lands of
Edmund Buell & being the same tract or parcel of land conveyed to the said Margaret &
some by deed from Richard L. Seabree together with all and belonging thereto she has granted &
affirmed to acknowledge to the said Buell of the said tract or parcel of land containing or in anywise
containing and Edmund Buell the said tract and parcel of land together with all and belonging
thereto she has and will to have the former hereby conveyed unto the said Buell
Margaret & some one of all & every other present or future acknowledgment. In Witness whereof
the said Margaret & some have hereunto set their hands & affixed her seal this day of June above written.
