This Indenture made and entered into this first day of May one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Henry Fowler of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Abner Reddick of the County of Norfolk and State of Virginia of the second part Witnesseth that the said Fowler in consideration of the sum of sixty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Abner at the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has his said Henry Fowler heirs assigns and sole and by their persons or assigns and all who he said Abner Reddick shall lawfully claim interest as well as all and every other interest to which the said Henry Fowler may have in and to a certain tract of land now held by Elizabeth Edmund as her dower on the lands of the late School Johnson now occupied and possessed of said Remondson) right or interest in Remondson and also his interest as Remondson or Remondson to the above here by the said Elizabeth Edmund as her dower on the lands of the afore said School Johnson to wit Comfy Port and King Hill Point once to hold unto him or interest in Remondson or Remondson or to be divided and also to his interest in said slave notwithstanding the future conveyance of the same from him the said Abner Reddick his heirs executors and administrators forever and the said Henry Fowler will for himself and his heirs the aforesaid right and interest in Remondson forever remain and defend against himself and his heirs and all who say Remondson or Remondson under this title interest was purchased by me of Stevens Edmund who says my wife as well may fully appear by reference to show unto A.
