 kitchen furniture and all of my best of land feather beds, a feather mattock and singular
 appurtenances to the said tract or part of land belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the
 future increase of the female of the said slaves, and all the said right title and interest
 of the said Thurgood Lair are and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract
 or part of land and premises to the said Taylor St. Billoe his heirs successors administrators
 and assigns forever to hold the said tract or part of land and premises together with the appurtenances
 thereto in fee simple for himself his heirs successors and administrators to have and
 to use and enjoy the said tract or part of land and premises and all the other personal property
 belonging thereto in fee simple for himself his heirs successors and administrators and assigns
 forever in manner and form following, That is to say that the said Thurgood Lair has here
 heretofore administered the aforesaid tract or part of land and premises with their appurtenances
