This Indenture made and entered into this first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three between William Barred and Mary his wife of Southampton County of the first part and Abram Reddick of the County of Norfolk and State of North Carolina of the second part Witnesseth that the said Williams Barred and Mary his wife in consideration of one thousand seven hundred ninety three dollars and twenty five cents paid to James Mills of Southampton County & at our request in full of a Debt of said Barred due to said Mills and wife to M. H. Vaughan trustee Received on the last office of Southampton County Virginia on the 2nd day of May 1764 Page 97 and also on the further consideration of the sum of other hundred and seventy eight Dollars to us in hand paid by the said Reddick before the entering and delivery of these presents the Receipt of which we do hereby acknowledge. We this said William and Mary Barred have bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Abram Reddick all the right title interest or claim in and to the tract of land in Southampton County known as "The Barred" said to contain five hundred and eighty four acres more or less and bounded by the Rappahannock River from the Town of New River down to the lands formerly owned by the late William Allott thence along said Allott line as witnesseth James G. a farmer on said Allott line for the lands of the late Lafayette Brown thence along said Thomas line and westerly thence to the back town of New River all of which will more fully appear by reference to a Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Brown and wife to Nelson H. Dodge bearing date the 21st day of April 1767 it being the same tract of land as is therein conveyed and the Rappahannock and Potomac Rivers and Potomac north the Rappahannock and Potomac thence along north all right title interest claim or demand of or with the former tract or parcel of land with all and singular the improvements and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining. It is Witness and to hold to him the said Abram Reddick his heirs executors or assigns forever.
