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This Indenture Made and entered into this 1st day of June in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three between William Murphy of the one
part and Joseph Prillow of the other part Witnesses that the said William Murphy
for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars in hand paid by the
said Joseph Prillow at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said William Murphy has granted bargained sold
and conveyed and sold by these presents grant bargain sold and conveyed unto the said
Joseph Prillow his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever the following tract parcel
or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and known as the Purchase
of the late Sarah Briggs ad containing by Metes and Bounds Four hundred and eighty seven acres
more or less which said land the said William Murphy bought of Benjamin D. Pratt under a
title as trustee and James Johnson and wife of the the County of Greenville as and there
fully appear by reference to said Deeds of Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County
together with all the privileges & appurtenances to the said land in any wise appertaining
and belonging unto the said Joseph Prillow his heirs executors administrators and assigns
forever He Wrote with He Wrote the said tract or parcel of land with all the buildings
and other improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging and all the title
right title and interest of the said William Murphy thenceforth the said Joseph Prillow has
had and assigns to him and their heirs forever and his heirs and assigns and the said William
Murphy for himself his heirs executors administrators hereby covenants to and with the said
Joseph Prillow his heirs executors administrators and assigns that he will forever warrant & defend
against the right and interest in the aforesaid piece or parcel of land hereby conveyed or
intended to be conveyed together with the buildings and improvements thereon and the title
belonging and the appurtenances to the said Joseph Prillow his heirs and assigns against
the claim or claims of him the said William Murphy or his heirs and all and every person
claiming the same or any part thereof by thought or word hereafter whosoever the Witness
whereof the said William Murphy hath thenceforth set his hand and affixed his seal this day and
year forthwith written

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This Indenture Made this 20th day of July A. D. 1844 between John W. Edwards of the
first part Henry Blum of the second part and Charles B. Knight of the third part Whereas the
said John W. Edwards alone fully indebted and the said Charles B. Knight in the sum of one
thousand & four dollars and 75^{cts} and by bond bearing date 20th day of July 1844 and also the
said Charles B. Knight became security for the said John W. Edwards to George Murrell for
the sum of fifty five dollars fifteen of which will be due the 20th day of Decr 1846 fifteen
of which will be due the 23rd day of Decr 1846 fifteen of which will be due the 20th
day of Decr 1847 and whereas the said John W. Edwards desires to recover and be
