Edwards shall return payment of the aforesaid property until paid of payment of the above sum as much thereof as may then be due and owing to the Plaintiff to himself his heirs executors administrators &c and when the said John H. Edwards has received his executors etc shall require the said Harry Bloot to make sale of the property above named or as much thereof may think sufficient to satisfy the aforesaid debts and the sume of damages he the said trustee & shall or in case of his death by his representation to act after having given reasonable public Notice of the time at place of sale process to sell to the highest bidder for each the aforesaid property and of the proceeds of such sales on the first & following day until satisfy all monies due and the damages thereon pay and satisfy the aforesaid debts due to the said John H. Edwards and sonnake Warratt his heirs &c and the surplus of any money to be another H. Edwards but on the other side of the Settlement where the said parties have bound their hands and offered their seals the day and year above written.
