Whiting and Catharine Prentiss are justly indebted to the said Dr. P. Baylies in the sum
of seven hundred Dollars as due by him according to the first day of January next.
Now fully appears which with much the legal interest accrued since the said William Whiting
and Catharine Prentiss are willing and desirous to sever from the aforesaid
for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of our Doctor
Catharine May of Virginia to the said William Whiting and Catharine Prentiss in hand
paid by the said Dr. P. Baylies or before the making and delivery of these presents
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said William Whiting and Catharine
Prentiss have given granted bargained sold and confirmed unto their friends as follows
Bacon all and confirm to the said Dr. P. Baylies his heirs and assigns forever all that certain
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Hampshire and state of Virginia
whereof both sides have had right and sufficient and more likely the property of Joseph
Lamb by whom it was set to the aforesaid William Whiting and Catharine Prentiss
containing five hundred and eighty acres more or less to the same there or less bounded as
follows to wit by the tract of Patrick Dole which contains the following lines of the old
back River side beginning to the head of the back swamp thence down that course
of said swamp to a spring a corner in the North Dole land thence along a small branch
bearing the head of the North Dole land to a forked stream thence along as line of marked trees
to Peter's Dale line with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land
belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the rights rights title and interests of the said William
Whiting and Catharine Prentiss in or to the said parcel so named to be hereby granted and or parcel
of land and premises as above and to Whiles the said jointly granted or intended to be jointly
