other party Whereas it is known to the said William G. Senior in consideration of the sum of Three
hundred Thirty Dollars of lawful Money of the Commonwealth to him in hand Paid (or
accrued to be Paid) at or before the recording and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged. Now therefore and it is by these presents the Receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged. Whereas Burroughman and sale and by these presents doth bargain and sell
unto the said Peter D. Burroughman a certain tract or parcel of land and
 premises lying and being, in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing
by Estimation one hundred and thirty two acres. At the same Mow or left and bounded by
the lands of Peter Parcellon to West or the South by the lands of Willa Lee, on the East by
the lands of said Willa Lee, and on the North by the lands of John Chapman and Thomas Remond.
Whereas there being had with them fully appear together with all and singular the houses and
houses, out-houses, barns, gardens, orchards, meadows, waters and water courses, fence posts, fence rails,
commemorative monuments, boundaries and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land
belonging or appertaining, to the said or any part or parcel thereof. To Willd. the said Peter D. Burroughman
the said 156 acres of land, with the boundaries aforesaid and all and singular other the premises
