 and having found on the day and place of sale and given reasonable public notice thereof
 did on the day set up and sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash the said land
 as described as aforesaid together with the privileges and appurtenances thereto and at the sales
 made the aforesaid Nicholas M. Bobell became the purchaser of the said land with the
 privileges and appurtenances by bidding therefor the sum of Five hundred dollars which
 was the highest bid made for the same. Now Therefore this Indenture witnesseth
 that the said James M. Bobell for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars
 which he has received from the said Nicholas M. Bobell has granted conveyed and sold and
 by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Nicholas M. Bobell his
 heirs executors and assigns the aforesaid land heretofore mentioned and divided
 together with the buildings and improvements thereto belonging to him and to his the said
 tract of land with all the buildings and other improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto
 belonging and all the estate right title and interest of the said John M. Bobell. In witness
 to this said Nicholas M. Bobell his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use &c.
 from and the said James M. Bobell for himself his heirs executors and assigns hereby covenant
 to and with the said Nicholas M. Bobell his heirs and assigns that he will forever
 warrant and defend the said tract or parcel of land hereby conveyed with the buildings and
 improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Nicholas M. Bobell his heirs
 and assigns against the claims of him the said John M. Bobell and all other persons claiming
 the same or any part thereof by charter or other title but against the claims of his other
