and delivery of these presents the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have therefore
bargained and sold and by these presents doth give and hereby convey to said Barnes all
the rights title interest and estate which he the said Walter Pipper has in and to certain
lot and parcel of land situate to contain eleven acres, so the same more or less the said
