Williford the receipt whereof the said John Williford doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant sell and convey unto the said James B. Williford his heirs and assigns @ certain tract or parcels of land containing 176 acres in the said town of Lyndhurst in the said County of Southampton and known by the name of the recent plantation and bounded by the lands of Mr. D. Moore & Mr. P. Sturmer & Mr. Charles Butts & freshens for Creek Estles and Mill D. Sturmer & Mr. Lawrence to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said James B. Williford his heirs and assigns to the only purpose and intent to have the said James B. Williford his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Williford for himself his heirs his Successors and administrators doth hereby command and require to and within the said James B. Williford his heirs and assigns that he his and their goods Williford and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him the said James B. Williford his heirs and assigns against whom the rents from his goods Williford and his heirs and against all persons whatsoever shall and will by these presents forever remain and defend the said James B. Williford who the rents from his goods Williford his heirs and assigns set his hands and affixed his seal this
