His Indenture Make. the 1st day of Sept. in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty four Between S^r W. Willford (husband) and A. J.
Willford of the one part & Thomas W. Willford of the other part, all of the County of
Southampton State of Va. witnesseth that on consideration of the sum of Three
thousand Dollars in hand paid by the said Thomas W. Willford at or before the executing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said S^r
W. Willford (husband) hath granted bargained and sold and released and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell release and confirm unto the
said Thomas W. Willford his heirs and assigns all that parcel or parcels of land
comprised one tract containing Three hundred & forty one acres more or less and bounded
by the lands of James Vesper on the west S^r R. Mangum on the south T. W. Willford on
the East with Willard on the North also one tract of one hundred and more or
less and bounded by the lands of Willard Sever and Brown also the following
slaves and personal property to wit one Negro woman Mitty and two children
Five head and furniture being head of hogs fourteen head Cattle twelve head
sheep three horses one Boat one gig three barks & wheels two one barrel shits
sixty six cash forming upwards near half a kitchen furniture all my crop of corn
& further certain farms & parcels with all and singular the appurtenances to the said
tracts or parcels of land belonging or in any wise appertaining the above and to
hold the hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tracts or parcels of land
and furnished with its appurtenances together with the above slaves and all the
other personal property conveyed unto the said S^r W. Willford (husband) the said husband
relinquishes his right title or claim upon any of the above conveyed property de good and
release the tracts or parcels land and all other property with its appurtenances together
with the said Thomas W. Willford has hereunto and assigns forever in manner above and
also that it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Thomas W. Willford his heirs and
assigns from time to time and all times hereafter peacefully and quietly to use into have
hold occupy possess and enjoy the tracts or parcels of land slaves and all the rest of the above
conveyed property with its appurtenances forever the witnesseth I have hereunto set my hand
