

Third Indenture made and executed, this 17 day of July one thousand eight hundred and forty four by and between Nicholas M. Schell
of the one party and Samuel P. Nicholson of the other party both of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia - witnesseth that the said Nicholas M. Schell
and the said Samuel P. Nicholson at and before the making and delivery of this present indenture
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nicholas M. Schell - hath granted, bargained,
sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said
Samuel P. Nicholson his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever all certain
brick pieces or parcels of lands situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and
near the town of Fishmonger what is to say one brick containing thirteen and three fourths
acres more or less under building forty feet long @ half acre more or less and another
containing twenty one acres more or less known and designated as the Middle Lodge
more particular description may be had of said land by reference to a survey from
said Samuel P. Nicholson commissioneer to the said land dated December 14, 1843
together with all the privileges & appurtenances to the said land in any and everyting
belonging unto the said Samuel P. Nicholson his heirs and assigns forever. It is further
