Name West Dennis recent tract. The daughter Mary and her husband, child of Rev. Mr. West, namely, Dr. Harris and his wife to be the said Rev. & Mrs. Harris forever and their heirs and assigns forever. Now whereas that the said Peter Edwards shall at the request of either or both of the aforesaid parties after giving all due consideration of the time and place of sale etc as parties aforesaid, at the first opportunity, a timely cause or so much thereof as will be sufficient, to satisfy said land to Dr. Harris and his wife and one of the premises first from the expenses thereof therefrom the debt due to the said Sarah D. Smith on which the said Edwards and Francis are bound as security and the balance to pay over to the said John Taylor or his legal (Representative) and the said John Taylor agrees with the said Peter Edwards that he is satisfied of the absolute title of the party holding and that he will, forever warrant and defend the same against having and all other persons whatever.
