Parker Esq<sup>r</sup> Jr., Bridget & Sofia Parker, are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia, as to just and full sum of Thirty Thousand dollars for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us and each of our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally forever by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1845.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Samuel B. Hines the present Sheriff of the County of Southampton is by Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1844 confirmed in the office of Sheriff for the said County for one year next after his inspection of his first Commission. If therefore the said Samuel B. Hines shall well and truly collect all levies and fees rates and accounts for and pay the same in such manner as is by law directed and also all fees feesfines and amonments arising or becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County, and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of the Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth as is or shall be directed in case of public funds and shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said office of Sheriff during his continuance thereon then the above obligation to be void & else to remain in full force and vertue.
