The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Samuel B. Jones the present Sheriff of the County of Southampton is by the Commissioners from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth of the third day of December 1793 continued in the office of Sheriff for the 7th County for one year that after the expiration of his first Commission of Sheriff the said Samuel B. Jones shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the Taxes imposed by law and arrears of taxes due in the said County of Southampton and shall faithfully collect account for and pay the Duties from importers to the Town and Arrears of Duties from due in the said County of Southampton then the above obligation to remain in full force and virtue
