dollars to him in hand paid & delivered to be paid by the said Henry Moore the receipt  
whereof is herby acknowledged hereinafter, and shall and by this present Deed bargains  
sells and conveys unto the said Henry Moore one certain tract or parcel of land lying and  
being in the County of Southampton containing by late survey three hundred and forty three  
acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows by the lands of Mark A. James  
the land of Dr. David Newson dit by the land of Howell Scobrough and by the  
lands of Henry Moore the same lands which his Mother now resides in the same lands which  
William Ransley did and possessed of and all the right and title given to Allen  
J. Harrison by the last will and testament of William Ransley dit by these presents  
conveyed unto the said Henry Moore and the said Allen J. Harrison doth warranty and  
forever defend the right and title unto the said Henry Moore his heirs and assigns forever
