To Helle and to Holt the said master, lands and other property unto him the said
Samuel Helle he heretofore administered and assigns former Negroes T. & S. Holt
and Contractors that, at any time after the 2d day of August, 1782,5 whenever the said
Edward Burle comes to collect the aforesaid sum of one hundred fifty seven dollars
and cents and interest which may have accrued thereon, as may & shall be lawful
for the said Sam Helle or in case of his death for his legal personal Representative timely
authorized to act to make sale of the lands & other property before mentioned at
public auction to the highest bidder for such having paid on the day and place
of sale, by his own discretion and having given reasonable Notice thereof and out of
the proceeds of sale after satisfying all costs & expenses attending said sale & the conveyance
pay and satisfy the said Edward Burle the aforesaid debt & interest, then pay the
balance of any over to the said Sally Simmons or such persons as she may authorize to

grantly bargain sell above release and confirm unto the said Elizabeth A. Williams Virginian Brett
& Corinne Williams their heirs & assigns forever all the right title interest claim or demand which
they the said Anthony N. & Corinne C. Williams have or may have in or to certain tract or part of
land situated lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded by the lands of Richard
Ridley, Joseph W. Bushman, Simon Riles, Mr. Morris Miller, Peter D. Bushman, William & Howell, neither
by being the body of land, dated to Dely D. Williams by Mary Scarrill nor by her donee
hereunto set forth the thirtieth day of April one thousand eight hundred and four & recorded the
