Bennett has executed the said last Testage under the Seal of the said County the aforesaid lot, or parcel of land conveyed in the said last will, and therefore the said Squire, doth certify that, for and in execution of the premises and for the further execution of the same of one dollar in hand paid by the said Bennett to the said Squire the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William S. Bennett and his heirs forever all the Duties, rights, titles and interests, whether in Law or Equity, or unto the aforesaid lot, or parcel of land with its appurtenances, so that the said William S. Squire be any other person claiming under or through him shall in any manner whatsoever claim or demand any estate, or interest, of or unto the aforesaid lot, or parcel of land in any part, along with, from all and every action for the recovery thereof and from all and every estate, right, title, interest, or demand of or unto the aforesaid lot, or parcel of land in any part, through the said William S. Squire shall be utterly void, voidable, and having power by these presents the said Squire doth certify the parties of the first and second parts in these presents have borne set, their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
