Know the Testified That this 30 day of Jan 1745 in the year of our Lord our
thousand eight hundred and forty five before the said William Rose either of the
first party Robert & Griffin or his executors or Robert & Griffin's
trustees of the third party all of the County and State aforesaid doth agree that the said
William Rose for and in consideration of the sum of forty five dollars wher
it is due and owing to the said Robert & Griffin as well as all other monies which they

any contract of debt or any contract whatsoever as well as for the further consideration
of the sum of one dollar or there part by the said Robert M. Rose of aforesaid
