between William Morris of the County of Sussex of the first part, and Samuel
Kells of the County of Southampton of the second part, and Patrick W. Kellings and
Dawson Beale of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the third part
and whereas the said William Morris stands jointly indebted to the said Patrick W.
Kellings by bond bearing date the 15th day of February 1835 for the sum of
four hundred and thirty one dollars & 12 cents as also to the said Dawson Beale
by several bonds and having date the 25th day of November 1834 for twenty five
dollars & 50 cents and also having date the 25th August 1834 for fourteen dollars & 1 cent
also an account for three dollars & 75 cents and whereas the said William Morris being
desires to secure and have agreed to secure the payment of the several debts and
indebted to the said Patrick W. Kellings and Dawson Beale their heirs or assigns
with all charges standing the same or incurred by reason of the former by
mortgaging the property hereinafter mentioned unto the said Samuel Kells of the
