of England, Scotland and France, the said John Bay, of the one part, and  
Allen H. Warren of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and State of  
Virginia, witnesseth that, the said John Bay, hath this day bargained and sold and  
by these presents doth bargain sell and confirm unto Allen H. Warren, in certain  
tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Southampton for the  
sum of seven hundred dollars to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by the  
said Allen H. Warren, the said tracts of land containing by tale survey six hundred and  
fifty five acres be the same more or less, and bounded as follows to wit, by William H  
Cass land and the lands of the A. Brown by the land of Rebecca H. Brown formerly  
Norton, by the lands of Genl. A. M. Jones - Co. Howe and to hold the same with all  
and singular appurtenances thereto belonging and the said John Bay, like warranty and  
power defend the rights and title of the said tracts of lands unto the said Allen  
of Warren, and his heirs forever - the witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
