 the payment of his hundred and sixty four dollars 1 25 cent appearing in Note
 as well as the interest thereon each of which is now due together with the legal interest
 which shall hereafter accrue also the cost in every respect of recovering into effect
 the indenture and the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the
 said Sack Barnes of and before the making and delivery of this indenture the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Benjamin Phillips have bargained
