This Indenture Made this 25th day of March in the year one thousand eight
hundred and forty four by and between Sam^r Saylor and Nancy his wife of the
fourth party and Eliza Lashford of the second party testifying that the said
Sam^r Saylor and Nancy his wife for the Consideration of the sum of twenty five
dollars paid to them by the said Eliza Lashford and the said Sam^r Saylor and
Nancy his wife did by these presents sell unto the said Eliza Lashford one
certain tract or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
containing by estimation fifteen acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows
beginning at the road by a red oak tree down Harrison's Branch to the
branch called the Meadow branch thence down the said branch to the road thence
up the said road to place of beginning and the said Sam^r Saylor and Nancy his
wife did by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Eliza Lashford the
aforesaid lands and its appurtenances to have and to her heirs forever and the said
