into grants bargains and sell and by these presents hath granted bargained and  
sold and covenanted pieces of land known by the name Nelson Ward lands  
extending by estimation forty five acres to the same there a tye stone lying and  
being on the County and State aforesaid and bounded as aforesaid in the  
test that John Jones gave to Eliz<sup>t</sup> Soper bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> day of April  
1741 together with all houses and the appurtenances belonging to the said land
